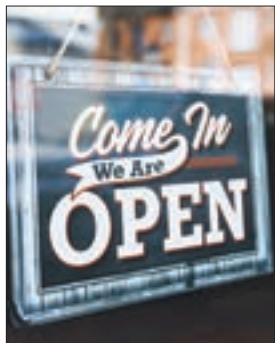

Municipality calls for province to reinstate uranium ban

MODL - The Municipality of the District of Lunenburg (MODL) is asking the Nova Scotia Government to once again, impose the ban on uranium.

The exploration and mining of uranium had been prohibited in Nova Scotia for the past four decades. The moratorium was put in place following extensive consultations with Nova Scotians from one end of the province to the other. Premier Tim Houston took many by surprise when he lifted the ban this spring.

MODL had previously joined Pictou, Annapolis, and West Hants municipalities in writing letters asking the province to pause any uranium exploration until government had consulted with Nova Scotians.

In response, Premier Tim Houston sent letters to two of the municipalities containing a list of projects that received provincial funding. In those letters Hous-

ton indicated if the municipalities want to continue receiving funding, they will need to get on board with the premier's plan to generate revenue by allowing uranium mining.

Mayor Elspeth McLean-Wile says MODL did not receive a letter like that received by other municipalities. She hasn't seen any data to show these mining projects will be an economic boon and she's troubled that the premier is attempting to tie the ability of the province to fund municipal projects to the municipality's willingness to allow mining.

"I see it as an oversimplification of the issue because it's not clear what the revenue stream will be from any of the minerals listed in their list," said McLean-Wile.

MODL went a step further last week after they received a 19-page staff report on uranium mining. McLean-Wile says the report highlighted the need for the province to slow down and listen to residents.

"We asked for a moratorium, and we

asked for public consultation and an assessment of the risks and benefits which, for me, that's much more encompassing because then it's based on facts and not just pure emotion. There's a lot of emotion attached to this because we've had this consultation before."

The four municipalities are united in asking for the provincial government to hear the public's concerns before pushing ahead on any plans. Mayor McLean-Wile says the province has the duty to consult with Nova Scotians.

"They're not even following their own criteria for assessing mineral exploration," said McLean-Wile. "In fact, in the provincial government's own strategy around mineral exploration, they have criteria set out around public engagement, public awareness, and they completely, in my mind, disregarded that."

The mayor understands as a rural municipality, resource development plays a key role in their local economy, but those resources need to be managed wisely, "I think that generally, we recognize that we have opportunities here that could really support a strong economy for the future

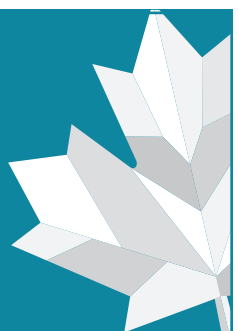

Canada Post update

NATIONAL – On June 12, the Minister of Jobs and Families approved its request for a vote to take place on the company’s final offers to the Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW).

The union believes that the Minister’s decision was “an assault on collective bargaining rights.” In December, former Minister of Labour, Steven MacKinnon put the union’s legal strike on hold. Jan Simpson, the union president in a statement said, “these repeated government attacks have poisoned

the bargaining process.”

On June 19, Canada Post reached an agreement with the Canadian Postmasters and Assistant Association (CPAA). This is Canada Post workers second biggest bargaining unit. The CPAA represents postmasters and people who work in post offices, in rural and northern communities across the country.

Canada Post is still working towards an agreement with CUPW.

Even though Canada Post came to an agreement with the CPAA, the corporation has not come to an agreement with the CUPW.

but we need to have public involvement in deciding where those investments should be from the government and what is in our best interest from a resource development point of view. I think there’s certainly less riskier areas than development of uranium.”

McLean-Wile says the public is very concerned about the potential for uranium mining. She says many people have come to council to speak about the proposals, councillors have been approached personally by residents and

communities have taken it upon themselves to host meetings right across the municipality.

Resource management policy comes from the provincial government and municipalities have no ability to interfere in that process, but McLean-Wile says council can help amplify the voices of their community.

“It’s not in our wheelhouse to be in this business, however we do have a role to represent our residents and to advocate for safe and healthy community. So, from that perspective we can advocate.”

Strawberry Shortcake

SHORTCAKES

- 2 1/4 cups (295 grams) all-purpose flour
- 2 1/4 teaspoons baking powder
- 3/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 3 tablespoons (40 grams) granulated sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon fine sea or table salt
- 6 tablespoons (85 grams or 3 ounces) unsalted butter, cold, cut into chunks
- 2 large egg yolks
- 3/4 cup plus 2 tablespoons (205 ml) heavy cream
- 3 tablespoons (35 grams) raw or turbinado sugar

FILLING

- 1 pound (455 grams) strawberries or mixed berries, hulled and halved if large
- 2 tablespoons (25 grams) granulated sugar, or more to taste
- 1 tablespoon (15 ml) fresh lemon juice (optional)
- 1 cup (235 ml) heavy or whipping cream

INSTRUCTIONS

SHORTCAKES

1. Heat oven to 400 degrees F. Line a large baking sheet with parchment paper.
2. In a large bowl, whisk together flour, baking powder, baking soda, granulated sugar, and salt until thoroughly combined.
3. Add butter and using your fingertips or a pastry blender, break it into small bits, the largest should be no bigger than a small pea.
4. In a small bowl, whisk yolks with a splash of cream, then pour rest of cream in and whisk to combine.
5. Pour into butter-flour mixture and use a rubber spatula to mix and mash it together into one cohesive dough.
6. Divide dough into 6 (for large, 3 1/2 to 3 3/4-inch wide and up to 2-inch tall) shortcakes or 8 smaller ones. Press dough somewhat flat into the bottom of the bowl (to form a circle) and using a knife to divide it into pie-like wedges.
7. Place raw or turbinado sugar in a small bowl.
8. Roll each wedge of shortcake into a ball in your hands and roll it through the raw/ turbinado sugar, coating it in all but a small area that you should leave bare (sugar underneath the shortcakes burns, so better to leave it off).
9. Place it, bare spot down, on the prepared baking sheet. Repeat with remaining wedges of dough.
10. Bake for 15 minutes, until lightly golden all over. Let cool completely on tray or on a cooling rack.

FILLING

1. While shortcakes cool, prepare fruit and cream: Mix berries, 2 tablespoons sugar (more or less to taste), and lemon juice, if desired, in a bowl and let macerate so that the juices run out.
2. In a larger bowl, beat cream until soft peaks form. Add sugar to taste, or leave unsweetened, if that’s your preference.
3. To serve: Carefully split each cooled shortcake with a serrated knife. Spoon berries and their juices over bottom half. Heap generously with whipped cream. Place shortcake “lid” on top. Eat immediately and don’t forget to share!

Gender based violence engagement table

PROVINCIAL – Right now, Nova Scotia has the highest rate of self-reported intimate partner violence in the country, according to the Bridgewater police service.

In 2020 Portapique, Nova Scotia saw the worst mass shooting in Canadian history, where a man took the lives of 22 innocent people.

For almost 20 years, the individual responsible for those killings regularly abused and threatened his long-time intimate partner and exploited other vulnerable women through his denturist practice.

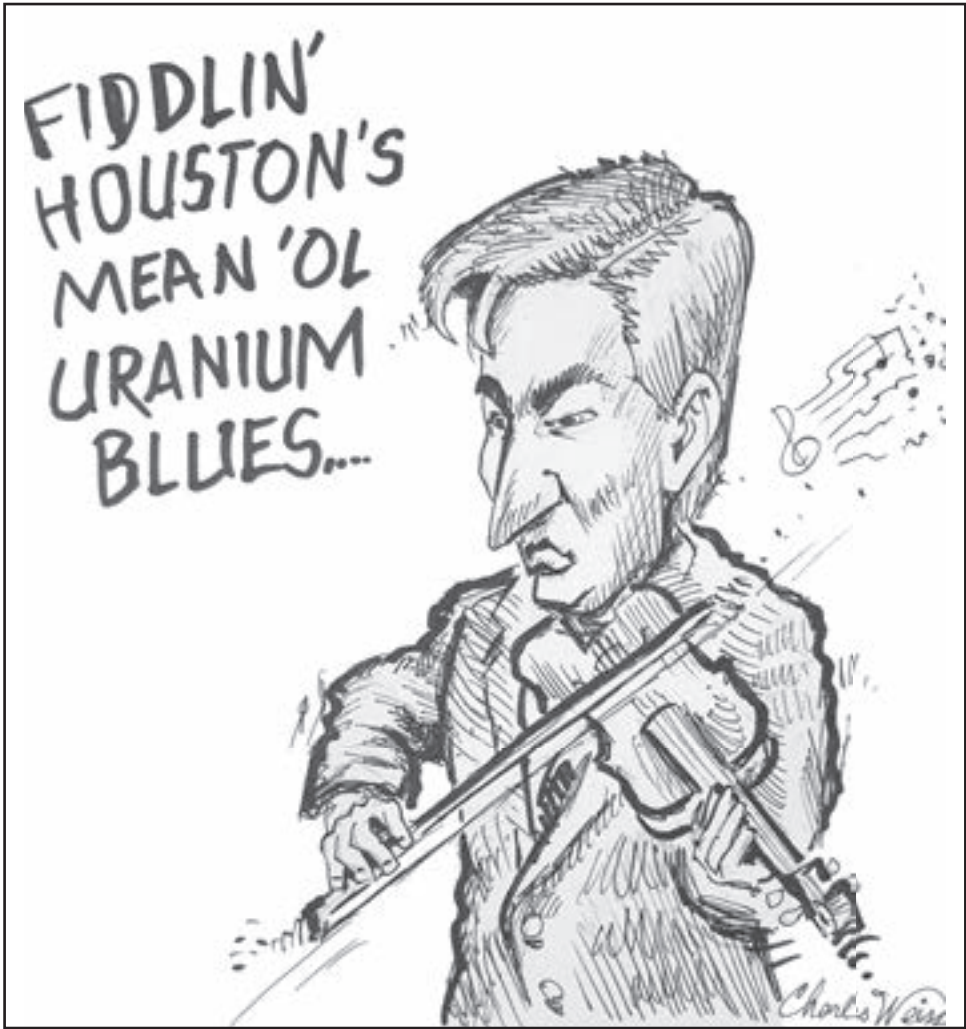
Almost four years later in September of 2024 the government declared intimate partner violence an epidemic in Nova Scotia.

In January 2025, a Mahone Bay man took the life his spouse in a murder suicide. This was followed by another tragedy in March, where an 83-year-old woman died in Bridgewater because of intimate partner violence.

These victims are two of eight that have lost their lives in the province due to intimate partner violence since September 2024.

To help address the epidemic, the provincial government is launching an engagement table to take further action to prevent gender-based violence in the province.

The table’s purpose is to find a way to help and support those who are victims, or who are affected by gender-based violence.



The table will be led by Attorney General and Justice Minister Becky Druhan, the MLA for Lunenburg County West.

The table, which will have up to 25 members, will include representatives of front-line service providers and community organizations, survivors, family members, and academic experts.

“Nova Scotians have told us that gender-based violence supports and services need to be more connected, more responsive and easier to access,” said Minister Druhan. “We need to work together with the people providing support and the survivors who access those services. It’s about understanding needs as they evolve, getting help to people faster and working together to stop violence before it starts.”

A call for applications made will be

issued in the coming weeks, and the group will meet at least once every three months.

The engagement table will be supported by the Minister responsible for the Advisory Council on the Status of Women as well as the ministers of Opportunities and Social Development, Health and Wellness, Addictions and Mental Health, Education and Early Childhood Development, L’nu Affairs and African Nova Scotian Affairs.

The 2025–26 provincial budget allocates more than \$100 million across various departments to address gender-based and intimate partner violence, including \$17.8 million in core funding for transition houses and women’s centers, which is the largest increase in two decades, for addressing domestic violence.

The Laughing Gull

Bird Notes

On June 14 I managed to slip away for a brief bird outing.

I was at Crescent Beach and was watching 50 common eiders, double-crested cormorants, herring gulls and great black-backed gulls. This was from the road in my car.

I was going to leave, but decided to take a few photos of the birds I was seeing. I walked from the car, closer to the beach, and that is when I saw an adult laughing gull with the herring

gulls and great black-backed gulls. If I had left I would have totally missed finding this bird.

The laughing gull nests on the gulf coast of Mexico, from Florida and Louisiana to Texas. They winter from North Carolina south to Central and South America, and the Pacific coast of Mexico. The laughing part of the name comes from its laughing or wailing call.

The laughing gull is 37.5 to 42.5 cm long with a wingspread of about 105 cm. The adult is white bodied and white-tailed with a dark mantle.

In summer there is a black head with white underparts.

The dark glittering eyes are encircled with white lids. The dark mantle blends into solid dark wing tips. The entire rear edge of the wings has a white border.

The laughing gull captures small fish. They will steal fish from brown pelicans and sometimes will eat eggs and young of terns. They will eat earthworms or scavenge scraps thrown from boats.

We can pay attention to how we manage our money, so as not to be taken by surprise and dismay in the future. We can foster the future health of our relationships by planning events and cultivating connections today. Those are all useful outcomes of considering the future.

What about downsides? One example is conflict that can arise when two people have very different views of the importance of preparing for the future.

For example, Marcia is always looking ahead, planning ahead, preparing for the many things that could go wrong in the future. Garth has more of a 'live for today' focus. It doesn't take much imagination to see the opportunities for friction here.

Using Choice Theory terms, we could say that Marcia has a higher level of the need for security/survival than does Garth. Her picture of satisfaction contains supplies of food, college funds for the kids, and a disaster plan for the future. Garth's satisfaction picture is one that shows the whole family on adventures that they'll look back on with delight in the future.

Both pictures have value. Can they be reconciled?

Self-evaluation is an important component of reality therapy. That is, we look at what we are doing and essentially ask ourselves, "How is this working for me?"

Brad Armstrong of Chester has a gray catbird that has taken up residence and comes every day to take a bath in a water container that he has put out for the birds.

He had a few ruby-throated hummingbirds earlier but none now. Brad hasn't seen them for a few weeks and hopes that the cold temperatures did not get them.

When the ruby-throated hummingbirds have young they stick to an almost insect diet, so during that time you won't see them coming to the feeders. Once the young are out and about, they come back to the feeders. Let us hope that this is what is happening to the hummingbirds that Brad had.

A western kingbird was reported in Canso. There also is a magpie there,

but it has not been confirmed as being countable at this point. Logan Moore posted a swallowtail kite in Strathlorne in Inverness County. On June 16, Angela MacDonald sighted a black tern at the Port Bickerton Lighthouse. There have been several other rarer birds reported across the province such as scarlet tanager, great-crested flycatchers, a wood thrush and sandhill cranes.

Alex d'Entremont and Kathleen MacAulay saw a pair of laughing gulls in Yarmouth County, but no signs of nesting this year. There was a nesting pair on a nearby island last year.

Thus, a question that Marcia might find helpful, “Is my focus on the future helping the relationship? Or hurting the relationship?” Similarly for Garth, “Is my lack of focus on the future helping or hurting the relationship?”

Notice that even though the focus is on the future, these questions are really asking, “How is my behaviour today affecting this relationship today? Is what I am doing today making things better or worse?”

Marcia and Garth have different pictures of what a successful, satisfying future looks like. However, both of their pictures include a loving relationship with each other and an intact family

that enjoys time together in safe, secure surroundings. They may differ in the details, but those big essentials are shared by both.

In the worst case, their differences over how to prepare for the future could endanger that important picture. That is, they could lose the big picture by arguing over details; such as how much they need to save versus spend, what constitutes irresponsibility versus family fun, and so on.

Before Marcia and Garth get too entrenched in their positions about who is right or wrong, it may be worthwhile to look again at what they really want. Look together. Even if their pictures of an ideal future are different, both want to share that future with each other. Conversation, rather than argument, may be the tool that can help them reconcile their different pictures.
